The Admission Plans do not include the price of snacks and drinks, which will be available for purchase during program hours. Please send your teen/tween with Singles, as we cannot provide change for large bills. If your teen/ tween is not in the correct grade all monies that have been paid will not be refunded.

YMCA holds the right to refuse entry into this program. The events during this program are subject to change at any time. Any teen/ tween that does not follow program rules will have a parent called to be picked up. The YMCA is not responsible for any lost or stolen items. All bags, backpacks, purses and anything that is used to carry items will be searched. All participants will also be asked to have their pockets emptied. Early Registration is allowed and preferred!

#### **Program Rules:**

**Parents and Teens/tweens should read the following rules carefully!**

**Anyone caught breaking any rules will have parents called!**

1. Teens/tweens must be enrolled in 5th through 8th grade to participate. A new permission slip is required for each program date.
2. Teens/ Tweens are not allowed to enter the facility until 7:30pm.
3. Teens/ tweens must be picked up **INSIDE** the building promptly at 11:00pm. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
4. Teens/ tweens must be picked up by 11:15 or social services will be contacted.
5. No foul language, fighting, bullying, threatening, weapons, alcohol, drugs, or smoking is permitted. All bags, backpacks, purses, towels, anything that is wrapped up and anything that is used to carry items will be searched. All participants will also be asked to have their pockets emptied.
6. Destruction of YMCA property (including staff & participant property) will not be tolerated. Parents will be held responsible for any costs associated with property damage. Any destruction or trashing of any part of the YMCA the participant will be asked to help clean that area.
7. Inappropriate physical contact between teens/ tweens is not permitted.
8. Teens/ tweens must wear appropriate clothing this is to the discretion of the supervisor on duty, if you are not wearing appropriate clothing you will be asked to change or call someone for different clothing.
9. Teens/ tweens are expected to act in a courteous and respectful manner to everyone. No bullying, threatening, or picking on another child including spreading rumors.
10. Please no energy drinks (Monster, RedBull, 5 Hour Energy, Amp, or any other brand)



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11. Teens/ tweens can only be picked up by someone 18 years or older.

12. The YMCA is not responsible for any lost or stolen items (including snacks, drinks, money, wallets, and or cell phones).
