Why Choose the YMCA Child Care?

Relationships: Positive, warm relationships between counselors and children. Counselors make families feel welcome and involved. Children are relaxed and happy and have the opportunity to share and form friendships.

Environment: Plenty of indoor and outdoor activity space including classrooms, exercise area, Interact Zone, swimming pools, teen area, outdoor pavilion, playground, and walking trails.

Activities: The activities and atmosphere appropriately reflect the ages, desires and interests of the children.

Activities at the branch include homework assistance, science, arts & crafts, kidz lit, swimming, dance, zumba, yoga, and more!

Safety and Health: Play equipment and surrounding areas are clean and free from safety hazards. All counselors are trained and certified in CPR and First Aid. Procedures are in place to screen visitors and to ensure that no one leaves with a child other than a designated adult.

Administration: Counselors are trained and evaluated in activity planning, safety procedures, licensing, and emergency response. Evaluations of the effectiveness, responsiveness and overall quality of the program are conducted regularly. Counselor to student ratio exceed state guidelines.
