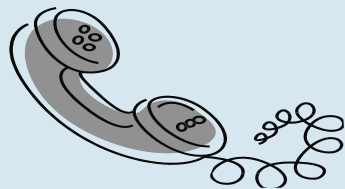

## 8th Period

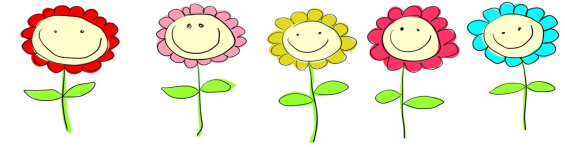
This program is the place for middle school-aged teens to hang out after school. No matter the activity, there is something for everyone to enjoy!
