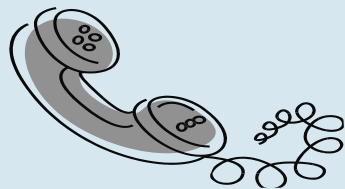

Program runs before and after school (6am-6:30 pm) in the following schools:

Battlefield, Berkeley, Brock Road, Cedar Forest, Chancellor, Courthouse Road, Courtland, Harrison Road, Lee Hill, Livingston, Riverview, Robert E. Lee, Salem, Smith Station, Spotswood, and Wilderness.

Before and After Care for Parkside will be served at the Ron Rosner YMCA, which is located right next door to the school.

We also provide care on Teacher Workdays and during school breaks. Our winter break camp, Camp Blizzard, and spring break camp, Camp Bonkers, are separate programs from SACC and require a separate registration fee and rate.

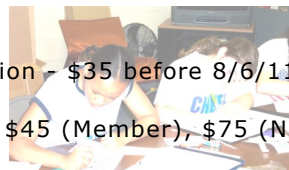
This program is the place for middle school-aged teens to hang out after school. No matter the activity, there is something for everyone to enjoy!
